

BASIC INFO FOR LEADERS

- The cost for Super Summer is \$250.00 per person through June 4. After June 4, the cost increases to \$270.00 per person. Registration includes lodging, meals, recreational activities, materials, and theme t-shirt. There are no additional required expenses but snack items and other sale items (such as shirts, stickers, books, etc.) will be available for purchase.
- All weeks of Super Summer take place at Webster Conference Center in Salina, Kansas
- Super Summer is open to all students who have completed the 6th Grade through those students who are graduating seniors in the spring of 2021.
- Only church groups can register for Super Summer. All individuals must register as part of a group. No individual registrations can be accepted.
- Sponsors must be at least 21 years of age to attend Super Summer. The suggested ratio is one sponsor for every 8-10 students. Make sure you have the appropriate number of sponsors for each gender.
- No infants or children may attend Super Summer.
- You will need a printed medical release for each student. If you do not already have these on file at your church, you can get one at supersummer.net. If you already have your church's own medical form, you do not need to use this form.

REGISTRATION INFO

Registration for Super Summer 2021 is completely online.

Churches pre-register their groups online at kncsbevents.org All youth leaders need to reserve space for their groups at kncsbevents.org as soon as possible. This step must be done before you can continue with registration.

Beginning March 1: Parents register their students online at kncsbevents.org/sscamper where they will also complete a Challenge Course Form online. Parents will submit payment to the church.

- The youth leader will receive an email every time a registration is entered for your group. You can also access your complete list of registrants by logging in at kncsbevents.org, clicking your registration history, and selecting this event.
- The number you pre-registered is the number of blank records you will have available.
- You will receive an email once the last spot in your group registration is filled. If you know you still need to register more people, contact Beth Payne (bpayne@kncsb.org or 785-231-4410) about increasing your registration number. Once you are sure that everyone is registered, you may delete any unused spots. Make sure this is done before you submit final payment. **Important:** Your registration cutoff date is determined by the week of camp you are attending (find this date in your confirmation email). Regardless of your cutoff date, the cost for Super Summer will increase to \$270.00/person after June 4.
- Once you are satisfied that your registration is complete with no errors, log into your account at kncsbevents.org to submit your group payment. You can pay online (preferred) by credit card or PayPal. If you are unable to pay online, you can click the pay by check option and issue a check to KNCSB and mail to: Super Summer, PO Box 361, Derby, KS 67037. Please only use this option if online payment is not possible for your group. **Payment needs to be submitted by your registration cutoff date.**
- Late registrations will be accepted only as space allows. Any additions after June 4 are considered late registrations. If your group space is full, please contact Beth Payne with any late registration requests.

SPONSOR INFO

SPONSOR REQUIREMENTS

All youth **MUST** be accompanied by a sponsor. The suggested ratio is one adult for every 8-10 youth. All sponsors must be 21 years of age or older. Sponsors must be capable to provide supervision and care for the needs of students. Super Summer does not provide an on-site medical staff. Sponsors will be responsible for administering first aid and any prescription meds brought by students. We are encouraging every church to bring a First Aid Kit.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT SUPER SUMMER

- Registration is from 2:00-3:00 p.m. in the Multi-Purpose Commons. Early arrivals will not be registered until the registration set-up is complete.
- Only adults are allowed in the registration area. Please ask all youth to remain outside.
- After completing registration, please transport your youth to their assigned housing unit. Do not allow anyone to change housing assignments. If you see an empty bed when you move in, chances are almost 100% someone will arrive to occupy that bed in the near future.
- After unloading and getting settled, youth and adults are free to participate in the recreational activities. At 4:30 p.m., there will be a sponsor orientation meeting, recreation will close at 5:00 p.m., and dinner is served at 5:30 p.m.
- Please park in designated parking areas. Do not park vehicles or trailers on the grass.

CHURCH GROUP MEETINGS

Each church will meet as a group twice a day, beginning Monday night. The meetings will last 45-60 minutes and the leadership of these meetings will be the responsibility of the sponsor in charge of your church group. Morning meetings will be Quiet Times (materials provided at camp) and evening times are more participatory. Materials for the evening meetings will be provided with your registration confirmation, or you may provide your own materials if you prefer.

K.P.

K.P. stands for Kitchen Patrol. Everyone does K.P.- students and sponsors. When you arrive at camp, you will receive your assignment. Every group is assigned to one meal. When you report for K.P., you will be given instructions and assignments (such as filling drinks, picking up trays, sweeping, scraping trays, etc.).
