



Collegiate Staff Ministry Description

The assignment to be on the Collegiate Staff is for any single young adult who loves Jesus, loves students and is willing to work hard.

The assignment consists of:

1. Spend one week at Webster Conference Center prior to Super Summer. You will assist with projects at WCC and will prepare for your service as Super Summer Staff.
2. Spend 6 weeks as Collegiate Staff at Super Summer. This ministry will include:
 - Recreation: The Collegiate Staff will be responsible for setting up and taking down the equipment for B.L.A.S.T. Games on Tuesday-Thursday each week. The staff will also be responsible to lead a team of students and sponsors each of these days at B.L.A.S.T. and setting the pace for enthusiasm and team spirit. In addition, there will be afternoon assignments on the Challenge Course and/or other activities. These are rotating jobs most weeks to provide a variety in the weekly activities. The Collegiate Staff will also direct the EXTRA B.L.A.S.T. Games.
 - Family Group Leader: From within your BLAST team, you will be assigned a group of students who will be in your Family Group. Each Tuesday-Thursday, you will lead two 25-minute teaching times (once with younger youth, once with older youth).
 - Encouragers: The Collegiate Staff will assist in the Encouraging Room by assisting students as they deal with spiritual decisions during the week at each Worship Celebration.
 - Kitchen Duty: The Collegiate Staff will be assigned to lead and help with K.P.
 - Go-For-Jobs: The Collegiate Staff will be responsible to assist other Collegiate Staff members and the members of the Youth Evangelism Staff in the day to day operation of the camp as needs arise at check-in, orientation, and throughout each week of camp with such things as Late Night and t-shirt sales.

This assignment is for those who are serious about reaching students for Christ and learning how to do Student Ministry. We will have fun, but the fun is found in ministry: praying, teaching students, playing with them to build a connection point, ministering to needs and being a servant.

Selected personnel must be available for the entire period of service, June 13-August 1, 2020. During Super Summer, the Collegiate Staff will work Monday morning through early Friday afternoon. The staff will then be given time off to rest and relax until Sunday evening. The Collegiate Staff will live on campus at Webster Conference Center during the entire time of Orientation and Camp.
