## WHAT TO BRING

- ❖ Casual clothes which meet the "Super Summer Policies" (see other side)
- ❖ Recreation clothes (*NOTE: Water games will be in abundance at Super Summer. Appropriate clothing in the form of swimsuits under dark T-shirts & shorts, and shoes that can be wet will be necessary!! Students should bring shoes & clothes which they are comfortable getting wet.*)

- ❖ Bedding (Bunks and mattresses are furnished.)
- ❖ Swimsuit (Dark T-Shirts are required in the swimming areas.)

## SUPER SUMMER POLICIES

- All youth are responsible to any sponsor or staff in regard to these policies.
- All youth are required to attend all scheduled sessions. If a youth becomes ill, medical attention is available and the youth, along with a sponsor, should report to the medical facility.
- Guys are not permitted in or around the girls' dorm areas and girls are not permitted in or around the guys' dorm areas. The only exception is during scheduled Super Summer class church group activities.
- Due to the anticipated capacity crowd at Super Summer, the Youth Evangelism Staff requires non-registered guests to abide by these simple guidelines:
  - ❖ When you arrive, sign the roster in the Chapel Foyer.
  - ❖ Guests are required to obey all guidelines, including dress codes.
  - ❖ Guests should actively participate in worship.
  - ❖ Guests should depart by 8:30 P.M. and may return at 9:40 P.M. if they wish to attend Late Night, unless otherwise approved by the Camp Director.
  - ❖ Non-registered guests will not be allowed to spend the night.

## **SUPER SUMMER POLICIES-continued**

- Dress is not to distract from the purpose of Super Summer. The following guidelines will help fulfill this purpose:
  - ❖ ALL clothing (shirts and dresses) must have sleeves.
  - ❖ All youth should observe a reasonable modesty in swimwear. Everyone must wear a dark T-shirt to, in, and from the swimming areas.
  - ❖ Backless dresses, and bare midriffs are not allowed. Hemlines and necklines must be modest.
  - ❖ Appropriate shorts will be allowed, but "short-shorts" and "message" shorts are not permitted. (Message shorts are those which have writing across the seat of the shorts.)
  - ❖ Shoes must be worn at all times. The only exception is while playing sand pit volleyball and swimming.
  - ❖ Clothing advertising inappropriate secular music groups/individuals, sex, tobacco, alcohol, and/or drugs shall not be worn.
  - ❖ All shirts must be long enough that no skin is visible above the waistband at any time.
- There will be no possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, and/or drugs except for the purpose of medication. Immediate expulsion will result from any violation of this guideline.
- Electronic entertainment devices (*such as C.D. players, radios, mp3 players, video games, etc.*) are not allowed.
- Only Sponsors and Staff may have cell phones.

If other guidelines must be set during the camp, they will be explained at an appropriate time.
